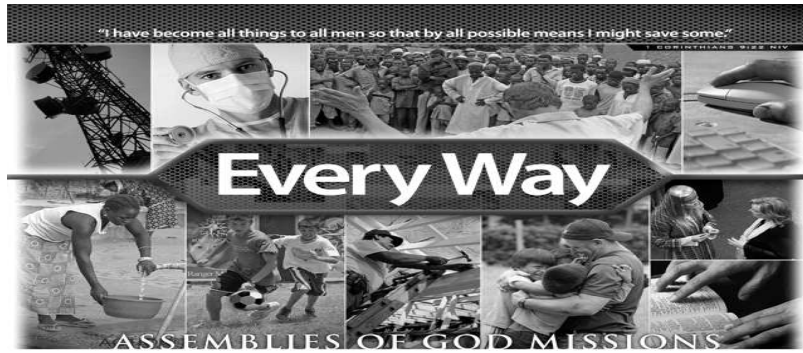

Welcome to our Annual Missions Convention Weekend

We have already experienced our "Taste of Missions" Friday Night, our combined ladies' missions brunch on Saturday morning, and our combined youth and young adult missions service here on Saturday evening. We trust they were inspirational to you as we endeavor to prioritize missions and missionaries for the year 2010. We welcome you and your family to church today!



This morning we extend a special welcome to Bob Hoskins and Devin Webb from "OneHope" Ministries. Bob has been a world missionary, a child evangelist, and, author and publisher. He is the Founder and Director of OneHope—a ministry devoted to developing tools to reach students with the Gospel. He spear-headed the global venture to get the Word of God into the hands of children and youth around the world by creating the *Book of Hope*—scripture books that combine the four Gospels with 100 study questions and include a clear plan of salvation. To date, the *Book of Hope* has been published in over 800 languages and has been distributed to more than 600 million children and their families in Africa, Latin America, the Caribbean, Asia, Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union.

● Faith Promises for missions will be received today.

► **What is a faith promise?** A faith promise is not your tithe or a portion of your tithe. A faith promise is a sacred act, a spiritual agreement between you and God as you commit to give regularly to help fulfill God's plan to reach a lost world.

► **Who can make a faith promise?** Every family can make a faith promise or each member—even children—can make individual faith promises.

► **What if I am unable to make a large faith promise?** No amount is too small. God honors and uses our obedience more than the amount of our giving. Limited income should not prevent anyone from making a faith promise.

► **Why should I fill out a faith promise card?** When members of a congregation make faith promise commitments, church leaders are able to determine how much the church can commit to support missions.

► **Who will know what my faith promise commitment is?** Only those who supervise missions funds will see your commitment.

► **If I have previously made a faith promise commitment, should I make a new one?** Yes. Each faith promise is made for a specific period of time, usually six months or one year.

► **When should I give my faith promise?** Some will give each week/others biweekly or monthly. People often give their faith promises on their church's designated Missions Sunday.

A faith promise give you an opportunity to participate in the Great Commission. As you do your part in missions, His purpose will be accomplished both in your life and in the lives of others around the world.
